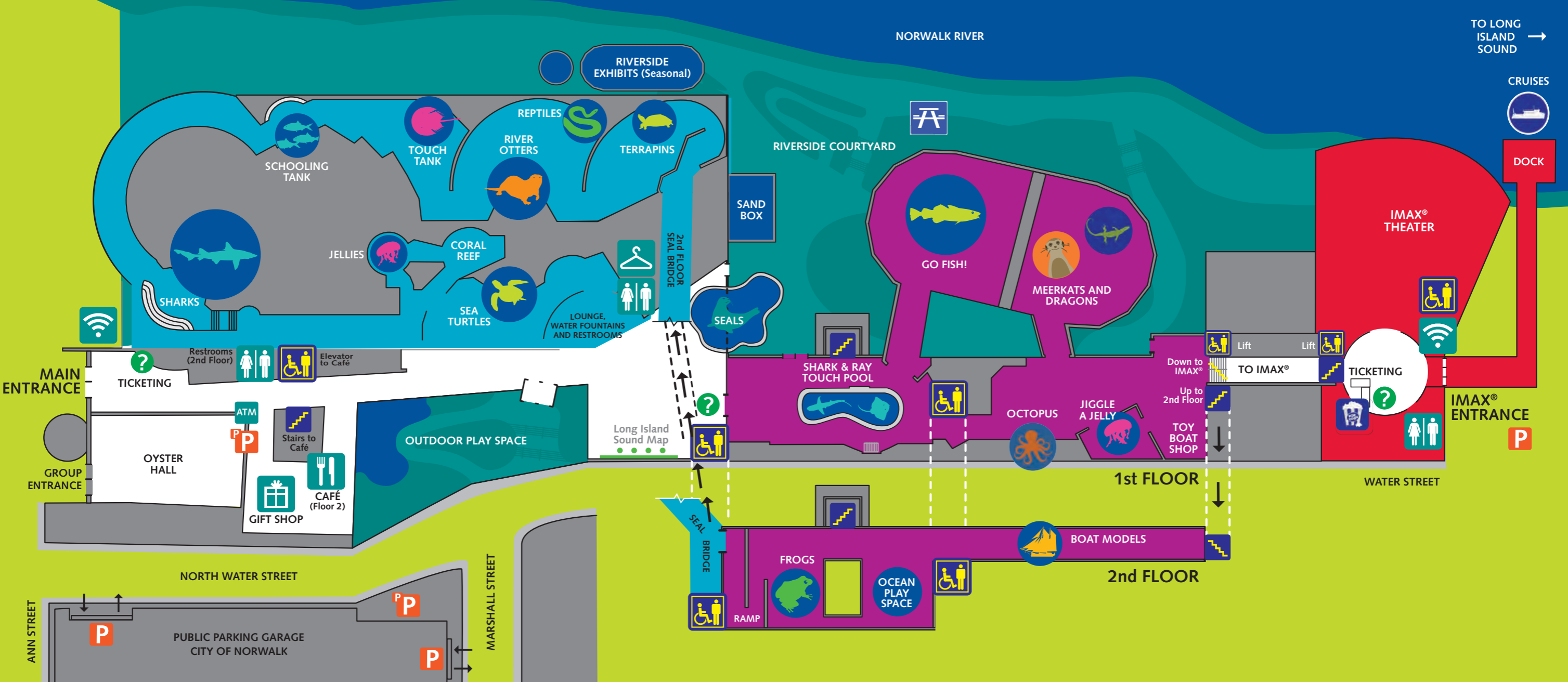

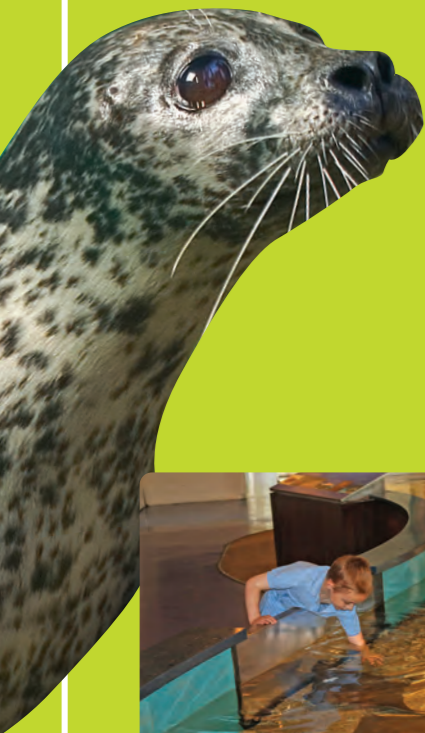

Harbor Seals

These marine mammals spend their winters here in Long Island Sound and travel north when the weather gets warmer.



North American River Otters

These energetic creatures live in the Sound's watershed—maybe even near you. Otters have very dense fur to keep them warm in cold water.



Horseshoe Crabs

At the Touch Tank, get a feel for an animal that has been around since before the dinosaurs! Doctors use their unique blue blood to detect diseases.



Ray and Shark Touch Pool

Get close and gently stroke the backs of prowling sharks and rays.

At home in the brutal desert, these cute creatures are fierce. They have to be to survive in the same habitat as hyenas, leopards and lions.



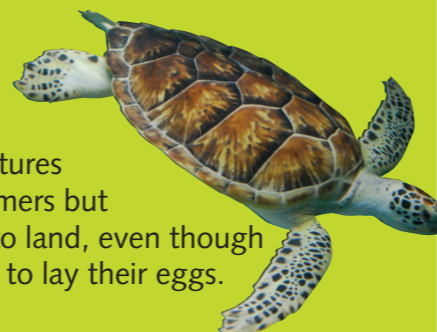
Sand Tiger Sharks
