### Achievements

**Seahorse Breeding** – SEA LIFE is a pioneer in the field of seahorse breeding, successfully breeding and rearing nine different species to date.

**Seal Rescue** – SEA LIFE and its sister brand the Sanctuaries annually rescues, cares for and returns to the wild more than 100 orphaned, injured and sick seal pups every year.

**Re-homing** – SEA LIFE provides permanent homes for brain-damaged and disabled turtles from all over the world.

**Active Campaigner** – The SEA LIFE network has petitioned governments to help improve conservation of sea turtle nesting beaches; to help outlaw the grisly shark-finning industry; to reduce the impact of by-catch on vulnerable species and many other critical marine conservation issues.

Turtles that are found injured or sick on beaches around the United States are rescued and cared for by more than 20 turtle hospitals across the country. The hospitals are true champions for the sea turtles, restoring their health and returning them to the wild or finding new homes for them in aquariums. However, the hospitals face tough conditions as many are limited in space and funding, often relying upon donations to fund their efforts.

SEA LIFE Aquariums throughout the US are coming to the aid of the hospitals by providing funding for things like lab equipment and medicine. In addition, many SEA LIFE aquariums are homes for turtles deemed un-releasable.
