

FREE ZOO RIDES®



Jungle Carousel

Children under 36" must be accompanied by a standing adult.



Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride. Children under the age of 6 years must be accompanied by an adult.

Tasmanian Tiger Family Roller Coaster

Children must be at least 36" tall, 3 years old and be able to hold onto the lap bar to ride. Children under 48" tall must be accompanied by an adult.

Overland Express Train

Children must be 4 years of age to ride alone. Children under 4 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

Boomer's Flyin' Bananas Children must be at least 3 years old & less than 100 pounds to ride.

Outback Bumper Boats Children must be at least 3 years old to ride. Minimum height is 30". Maximum height is 48". Maximum weight is 90 pounds.

NEW Lil' Joey's Caravan Children must be between 36" - 48" tall to ride. Sorry, no adults.

Expedition Africa Guided SafarisAny rider under 54" must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

*Rides may close due to inclement weather or other circumstances. Refunds are not issued due to closures. Ride restrictions are subject to change without notice.

Family Restrooms

Located at Garden Grille, Safari Africa and Wallaroo Station. Can accommodate wheelchairs.

Baby Changing Areas

Diaper changing tables are located in all restrooms.

Strollers/Wheelchairs

No outside food or beverages may be brought into the Zoo. Food and beverages are for sale inside the Zoo.

Clothing

Shoes must be worn at all times including in the Manatee Fountains.
